



## **Flood Project E-Update** **August 9, 2007**

### **Improve Public Safety, Health and Security**

**Downtown Bridge Review** – Flood Project’s Senior Licensed Engineer, Paul Urban, met with staff from City of Reno and CH2M Hill, who conducted a field study of the downtown Reno bridges, comparing existing bridge heights to the higher proposed bridge heights identified in the plan. The bridge sites included the Arlington, Booth, Center, Virginia, Sierra and Lake Street bridges. The field study will provide feasibility level costs for bridge replacement plan to the corps, and initiate the “Visioning Process” for the new bridge designs.

**Mustang Ranch Jet Fuel Pipe Realignment** – Flood Project’s Senior Licensed Engineer, Paul Urban, met with staff from the Nevada Land Conservancy, Kinder-Morgan Pipeline Company and various permitting agencies to discuss plan alternatives to realign the pipeline at the Mustang Ranch restoration site. This is the initial step in proceeding with the restoration plans for this site.
